Mark Mills is a Manhattan Institute senior fellow, a faculty fellow at Northwestern University's engineering school, and partner in Montrose Lane, an energy-tech venture fund. He is author of the book *The Cloud Revolution: How the Convergence of New Technologies Will Unleash the Next Economic Boom and a Roaring 2020s*, (2021), and previously: *Digital Cathedrals*, (2020), *Work in The Age of Robots* (2018), and *The Bottomless Well*, (2006). 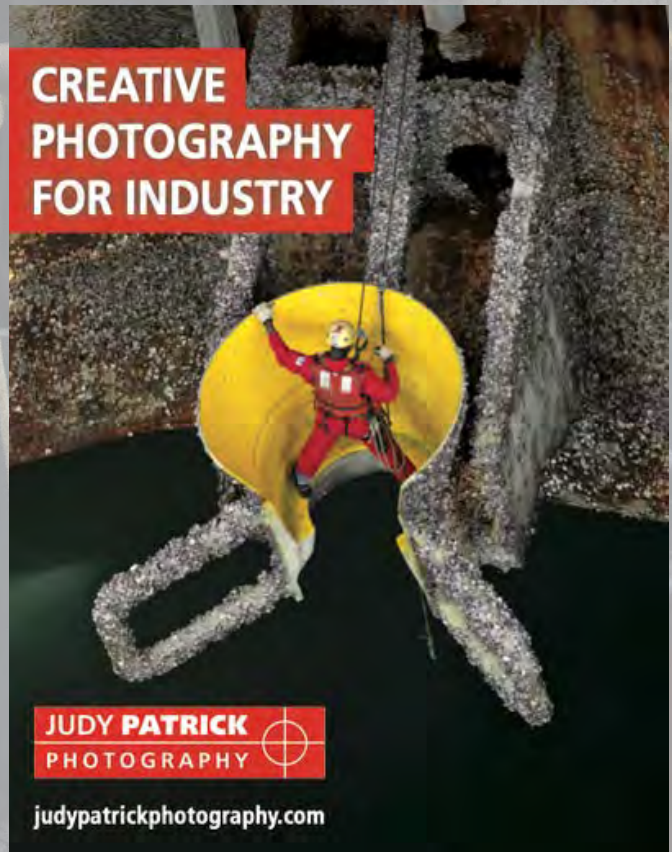
