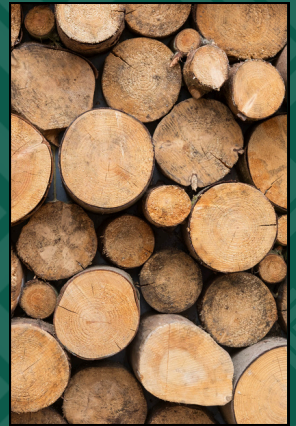

# Exhibitor Information

## Where is the event?

- The Dena'ina Civic and Convention Center is located at 600 W. 7th Ave, Anchorage, AK 99501. All load-in and load-out must be done exclusively through the loading dock located on 8th Avenue between F & G Streets (rear of the building). Do NOT use the front entrances—they are not permitted for exhibitor equipment drop-off. Parking on sidewalks is strictly prohibited. Carts and hand trucks are available at the loading dock for your convenience

## Where is my booth?

- The Exhibit Hall will be located on the third floor - both in the foyer and ballroom
- If you have already been assigned a booth space, please see the map on page 4.
- If you recently registered for an exhibitor booth, we will contact you soon with your assigned spot.
- Exhibitor space is subject to move as RDC sees fit.

## What does my 10' x 10' booth space include?

- Alaska Event Services, Inc. (AES) has been selected as the show service contactor and will provide: One 6' skirted table, black pipe and drape, two padded chairs, 500 watts of electrical service, and a booth identification sign. Please note that the exhibit space is carpeted, and chairs are provided by the convention center at no additional charge.

## What other items do exhibitors have access to?

- Conference breakfasts, networking breaks, and the VIP reception are all held in the exhibit hall areas. Your booth includes one all-access conference registration. We respectfully ask that "booth only" attendees, who are not registered for the full conference, please refrain from consuming food and alcohol. ## Parking:

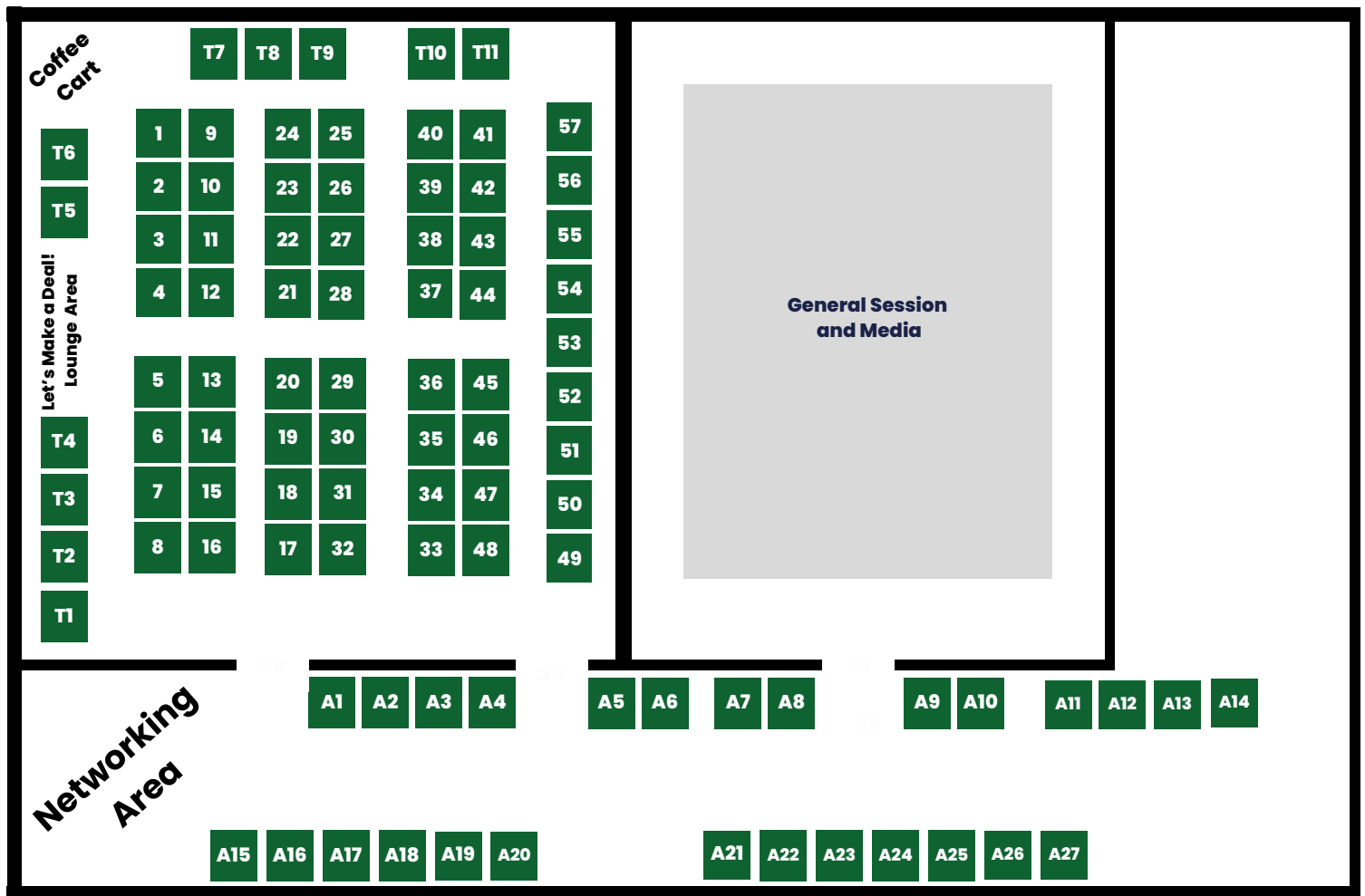
- Public parking is available in several areas surrounding the convention center.
