Industry, business leaders respond to oil and gas tax hikes in Gasline Bill

July 16, 2026 (Anchorage, Alaska) – The Alaska Support Industry Alliance, Alaska Chamber of Commerce, and Alaska Oil and Gas Association released the following statement in reaction to the Conference Committee's version of the [Gasline Bill, House Bill 381](#):

The conference committee bill misses the mark. Rather than focusing on advancing the Alaska LNG Project, it injects targeted industry and income taxes that threaten the very companies producing energy for Alaska's homes and businesses. The Alaska Oil and Gas Association, Alaska Support Industry Alliance, Alaska Chamber of Commerce, and Resource Development Council urge the Legislature to reject these counterproductive provisions and pass a clean bill focused on getting the gasline built and delivering lower energy costs for Alaskans.
